COURSE DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES

The National Amish Health Conference is the premier continuing education event for evidence-based, community led initiatives that have improved the health of the Amish and Plain communities. Speakers represent the Amish, Plain, rural, and healthcare communities and will address a variety of disciplines that impact the health of the community in culturally-sensitive manner.
